Climate change is irreversible. Rising sea levels and expanding deserts are destroying the foundations of people's lives. To survive, many have to leave their homes.

For many people, migration is not what they want, but rather their last resort. Climate change exacerbates already-existing problems, such as clashes over resources or lower yields in agriculture. An ambitious climate policy can therefore also mitigate the causes of flight.
