














Q15: What is your current living situation?






Q20: How would you assess the economic situation of your family today?

Jordan: Assessment of economic situation in 2010
















Q28: Is your father still alive?


Q29: How old is your father?
























Q48: What kind of neighbourhood do you live in?




Q50: What kind of housing / building are you living in today?





























Q67: What are the different sources of your budget? Multiple answers possible














































Q100: Have you ever made the experience of having to wait for being supplied with bread (except during Ramadan)?



















Jordan: Religion as private matter











Jordan: Part of a clique




Q129: Are you part of a fixed group of friends – a "clique" – that is meeting frequently and where everybody knows one another very well?







Q142: How would you describe the relations between the younger and older generations...?
















Q170: Do you rather agree or rather disagree with the following statements?


Q172: Where exactly did you live? Multiple answers possible






